


### Saved by the Bracelet

The שני לוחות, in his book of יודו לד חסדו הברית, comments on the verse וְנִפְלְאוֹתָיו לְבָנֵי אָדָם. The verse begins with וְנִפְלְאוֹתָיו לְבָנֵי אָדָם - His grace, which is in a singular version, and ends with וְנִפְלְאוֹתָיו - His wonders, which is in a plural version. The של"ה הקדוש says, that when a person thanks Hashem for the חסדים - the grace that he gets, then וְנִפְלְאוֹתָיו לְבָנֵי אָדָם happens, meaning that grace and redemption will come upon others as well. Remember, that when you thank Hashem, you're not the only one who finds salvation, but others find salvation as well.
