


Trip Rescheduled

חַצוֹת-לַיְלָה אֶקוּם לְהוֹדוֹת לַךְ עַל מִשְׁפָּטֵי צְדָקָךְ.
 The holy ראשית חכמה says that if a person thinks that hardships are bestowed upon us through מידת הדין, the act of judgement, he must remember that it is just the opposite. The hardships are brought upon us through acts of graciousness and mercy from Hashem. Just like it says in Tehillim, פרק ק"ג,
רַחוּם וּסְגוּן ד' אַרְךָ אַפַּיִם וְרַב-חֶסֶד.
 Hashem is full of mercy; He prolongs his wrath and always does great kindness to human beings.

Shoes and Inserts

My son has weak muscle tone by his joints in his feet, which causes him not to walk straight. The doctor recommended I buy him special shoes and inserts that would assist with his walking, and he gave me a prescription. Literally a minute later, I was told my insurance would cover most of the shoe, and the inserts fully! I was out the door 5 minutes later with the shoes and inserts my son needed.
